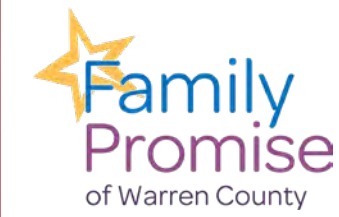

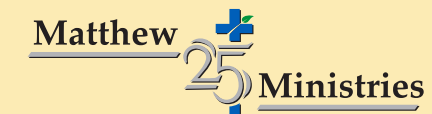


Stepping It Up

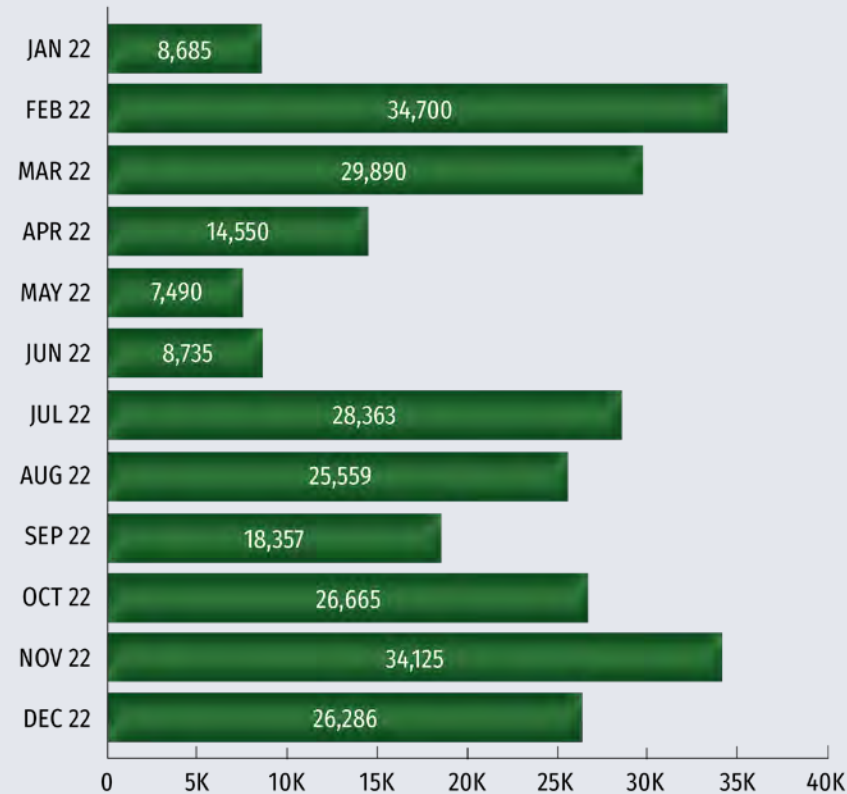

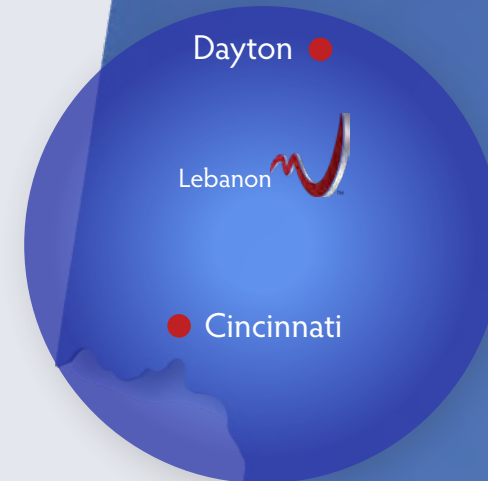
2022 Support by Month
