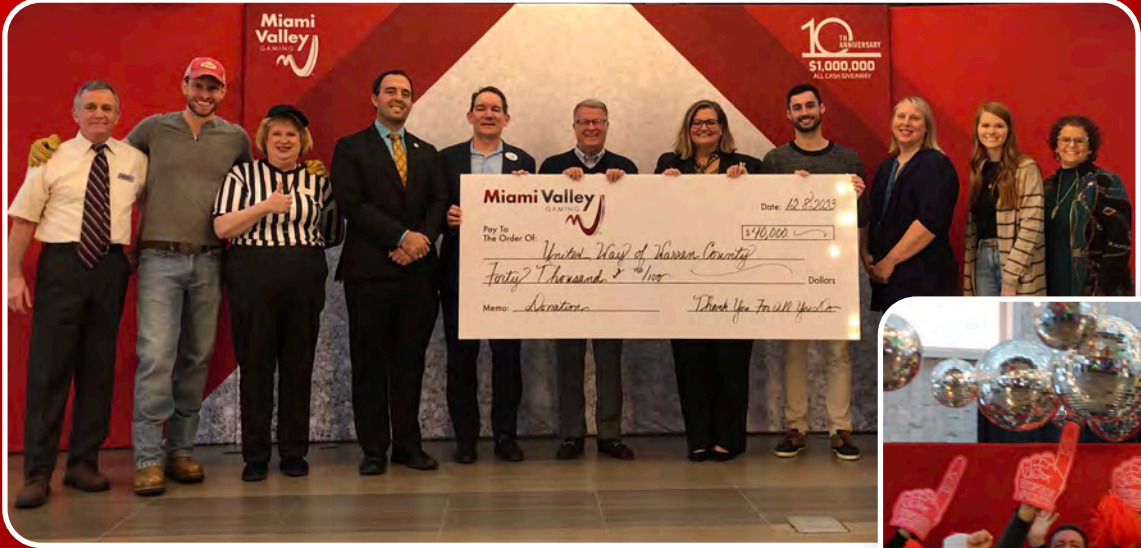


# Celebrating 10 Years With Our Community Partners

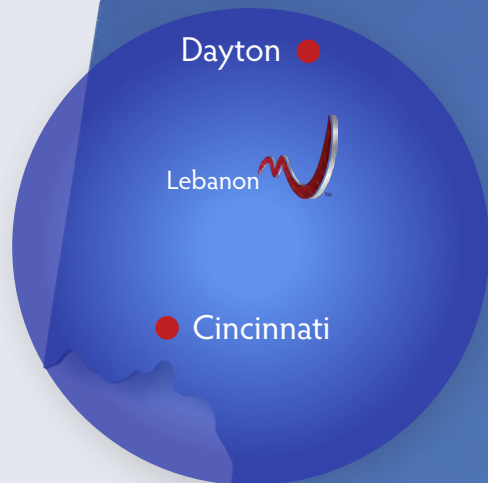
