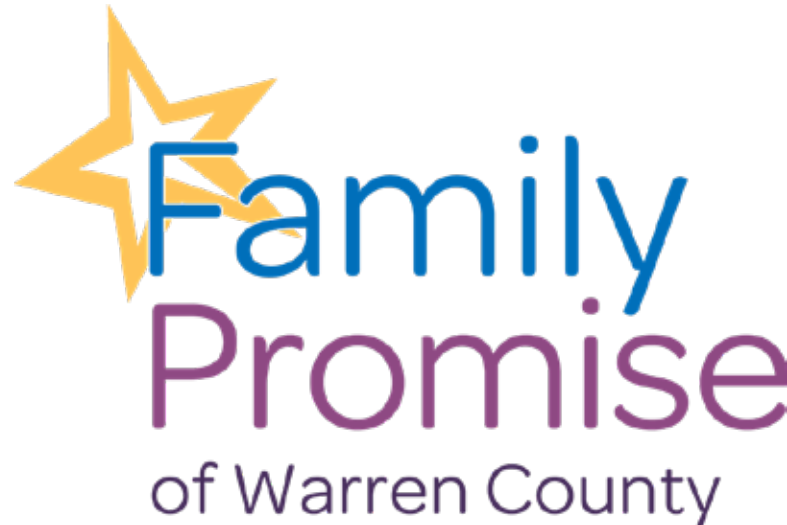
Special Efforts for Special Needs

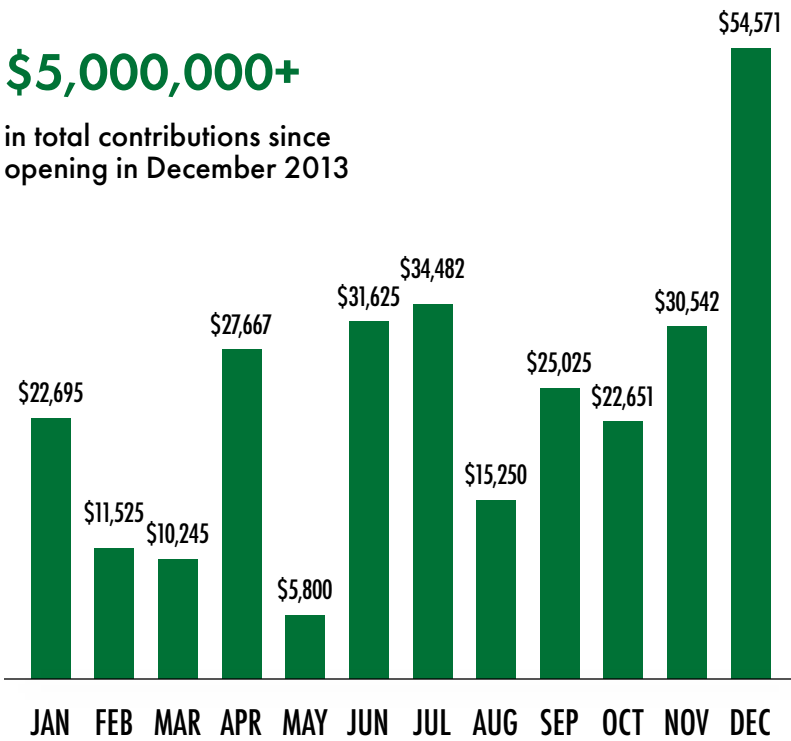


2024 Support by Month
